Dear Provider:

The Deficit Reduction Act (DRA) of 2005 mandates that all entities that annually receive or make five million dollars in Medicaid payments implement employee education programs on the detection and prevention of fraud and abuse. To assist you in delivering this education, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) has developed a web-based educational program on SoonerCare false claims. Here are the steps to access this program:

1. Go to www.oklms.org
2. Click on "New User Registration"
3. On the "User Employee Type Information" page, select "I work as a provider/contractor for a state agency, or for an employer who works with state agencies." You will be asked to provide some additional information to complete the registration process.
4. Once you are logged onto the system with your new user information, you will go to a HOME page.
5. On the left side of the screen click on "Online Courses."
6. You will be directed to a webpage that lists three available educational courses. Click the button beside "Identifying SoonerCare False Claims." The course should take approximately 45 minutes to an hour to complete. The computer will keep track of your progress, so you may exit the class and then reenter where you left off. Once you complete the course, a certificate will print for your records.
