**Compliance**

We have audited the compliance of the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center (the “Center”) with the types of compliance requirements described in the U.S. *Office of Management and Budget (“OMB”) Circular A-133 Compliance Supplement* that are applicable to each of its major federal programs for the year ended June 30, 2007. The Center’s major federal programs are identified in the summary of auditors’ results section of the accompanying schedule of findings and questioned costs. Compliance with the requirements of laws, regulations, contracts and grants applicable to each of its major federal programs is the responsibility of the Center’s management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the Center’s compliance based on our audit.

We conducted our audit of compliance in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America as established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants; the standards applicable to financial audits contained in *Government Auditing Standards*, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States; and OMB Circular A-133, *Audits of States, Local Governments, and Non-Profit Organizations*. Those standards and OMB Circular A-133 require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether noncompliance with the types of compliance requirements referred to above that could have a direct and material effect on a major federal program occurred. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence about the Center’s compliance with those requirements and performing such other procedures as we considered necessary in the circumstances. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion. Our audit does not provide a legal determination of the Center’s compliance with those requirements.

In our opinion, the Center complied, in all material respects, with the requirements referred to above that are applicable to each of its major federal programs for the year ended June 30, 2007.

**Internal Control Over Compliance**

The management of the Center is responsible for establishing and maintaining effective internal control over compliance with requirements of laws, regulations, contracts and grants applicable to federal programs. In planning and performing our audit, we considered the Center’s internal control over compliance with requirements that could have a direct and material effect on a major federal program in order to determine our auditing procedures for the purpose of expressing our opinion on compliance, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of internal control over compliance. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion on the effectiveness of the Center’s internal control over compliance.

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A control deficiency in an entity's internal control over compliance exists when the design or operation of a control does not allow management or employees, in the normal course of performing their assigned functions, to prevent or detect noncompliance with a type of compliance requirement of a federal program on a timely basis. A significant deficiency is a control deficiency, or combination of control deficiencies, that adversely affect the entity's ability to administer a federal program such that there is more than a remote likelihood that noncompliance with a type of compliance requirement of a federal program that is more than inconsequential will not be prevented or detected by the entity's internal control.

A material weakness is a significant deficiency, or combination of significant deficiencies, that results in more than a remote likelihood that material noncompliance with a type of compliance requirement of a federal program will not be prevented or detected by the entity's internal control.

Our consideration of internal control over compliance was for the limited purpose described in the first paragraph of this section and would not necessarily identify all deficiencies in internal control that might be significant deficiencies or material weaknesses. We did not identify any deficiencies in internal control over compliance that we consider to be material weaknesses, as defined above.

#### Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards

We have audited the basic financial statements of the Center as of and for the year ended June 30, 2007 and have issued our report thereon dated October 5, 2007. Our audit was performed for the purpose of forming an opinion on the basic financial statements taken as a whole. The accompanying schedule of expenditures of federal awards of the Center is presented for purposes of additional analysis as required by OMB Circular A-133 and is not a required part of the basic financial statements. Such information has been subjected to the auditing procedures applied in the audit of the basic financial statements and, in our opinion, is fairly stated, in all material respects, in relation to the basic financial statements taken as a whole.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Audit and Finance Committee, Board of Regents, management, federal awarding agencies and pass-through entities and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties.

## NOTES TO SCHEDULE OF EXPENDITURES OF FEDERAL AWARDS

Year Ended June 30, 2007

1. The purpose of the Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards (the "Schedule") is to present a summary of the activities of the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center (the "Center") which have been financed by the U.S. Government for the year ended June 30, 2007.

For purposes of the Schedule, federal awards have been classified into two types:

- Direct federal awards consisting of federal assistance and federal student financial aid, and
- Pass-through funds received from non-federal organizations made under federally sponsored programs conducted by those organizations.

Because the schedule presents only a selected portion of the activities of the Center, it is not intended to and does not present the financial position, changes in fund balances or the revenues, expenditures and other changes of the Center

Complete Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance ("CFDA") numbers are presented for those programs for which such numbers were available. CFDA prefixes and other identifying numbers are presented for programs for which a complete CFDA is not available.

The University passes through certain Funds to subgrantee organizations. Expenditures incurred by the subgrantees and reimbursed by the University are included in the Schedule.

The University is also the subrecipient of Federal funds that are reported as expenditures and included in the Schedule. The Detailed Schedule of Federal Award Expenditures denotes funding sources for pass-through funds. Federal awards other than those indicated as pass-through are denoted as Federal direct funds.

2. For purposes of the Schedule, expenditures for Federal award programs are recognized on a cash basis of accounting. Expenditures are recognized when paid.

4. The accompanying Detailed Schedule of Federal Award Expenditures for the Center, shown in Appendix B, is an integral part of the Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards.
5. The University of Oklahoma Norman Campus administers the Pell, Supplemental Education Opportunity Grants and College Work Study student award programs for students attending the Norman and Health sciences Center Campuses. Grant revenues and expenditures under such programs for students attending these campuses are included in the financial statements of the Norman Campus. Therefore, the Norman Campus Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards includes expenditures under such programs for students attending both campuses.
6. While not listed on the schedule, the Center also participates in the Federal Family Education Loan Program ("FFEL") which includes Stafford Loans, subsidized and unsubsidized, and the Parents Loans for Undergraduate Students ("PLUS"). The dollar amounts are not listed in the schedule as the Center is not the recipient of the funds. Loan disbursements under the FFEL Program for the year ended June 30, 2007 totaled \$57,343,892. Outstanding loans at June 30, 2007 under the Health Professions Student Loan Program (HPSL, PCL, LDS) and the Nursing Student Loan Program are \$4,949,389 and \$1,126,703 respectively.
