


Creating a Video Assignment in D2L

1. E-mail web-courses@ouhsc.edu to get Video Assignments added to your course.
2. Access the Video Assignments section of your course from the top navigation bar.
3. Click the "plus" button at the bottom right to set up a new Video Assignment.



4. Enter the Assignment Name and Due Date (if applicable). Grade Type can be adjusted. Peer Review is set to "on" by default. Note: A linked grade item will be created upon student submission.

5. Within a Content module in your course, click Add Existing Activities and chose Video Assignments. A list of your created Video Assignments will populate. Click on the one you wish students to access from the Content module, and a link will be created.
6. Once students have submitted videos, you can evaluate the videos from the Video Assignments section. By advancing the video player, you can leave time-stamped feedback.
