

Enabling TurnItIn for an Assignment Folder

OriginalityCheck lets you monitor Assignment submissions and identify potential cases of plagiarism by automatically comparing submissions to an online database of original content. You can then view Originality Reports which highlight key areas, show a breakdown of matching sources, and provide direct links to the matching content. GradeMark lets you add comments, inline text, and highlight sections in file submissions, directly from the Assignments tool.

1. From inside the course, on the navbar, click **Assessments > Assignments**
2. Click the “New Assignment” button
3. Click the Turnitin tab at the top
4. Select the **Enable GradeMark for this folder** and **Enable Originality Check for this folder** check boxed and click Save
