Background

FAS (The University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center's name for Digital Measures by Watermark) is an online faculty activity reporting system designed to assist faculty in completing and maintaining an accurate record of ongoing activities, services, and accomplishments (e.g., research, teaching, service, and national and international engagement).

FAS ensures that data you enter into the system can be used to generate standardized reports which include:

- Curriculum Vitae for Promotion and Tenure
- Annual Faculty Performance Evaluation
- Other Customized Departmental Reports
