VI. New Business: Doug Myers, Director for Parking & Transportation Services, gave an update about the new system they are developing to replace the parking hang tags. The entire gate system will no longer require the hang tag. Employee ID or Pike Pass will work. (At some point the department will sell a windshield tag for those who do not have a pike pass). Once the system is up and running they will have a license tag reader, and the decals on the back windshield will no longer be functional. Therefore, all vehicles will be responsible to pull into the parking place; no backing into the parking place will be permissible. The target date is December 2021 or beginning of January 2022. As you may or may not know, a Parking Facilities Master Plan was completed in 2019 and one of their recommendations included to replace the entire Parking and Revenue Control System. The existing management system is from a company that went out of business over 9 years ago. The equipment cannot be replaced, software cannot be updated, features cannot be added. There was no real-time dashboard to know parking conditions anywhere on campus. Why do we need new technology? The ability to see the growth in patients/visitors (transient customers) and the number of spaces they need; the ability to see vacancies in all facilities to move employee as close to work locations as possible; ability to plan for and serve conferences, events and meetings to park people appropriately; data to promote filling proximate spaces first and allows the department to track and understand patterns to use spaces effectively. The new technology will change operations, for instance new entry/exit credentials (faster, easier, no need to open window) for employees. As you are driving around the campus you may have noticed the new equipment going up. One of the new technologies we are installing is the Transcore tag reader. The device will read your toll tag as you are pulling into the gated area. The system will also read your current parking hangtag as well as your University ID card. We are ready for you to go in and enter your toll tag and University ID card credentials on your parking portal. (See attachment). If you don't have a toll tag, we have purchased a barcode sticker that will be placed on your windshield in the same vicinity as a toll-tag would be.

We will also ask that everyone will pull into their parking spaces, having your license tag toward the drive isle. One of the biggest complaints I have received since I have been on this campus in 2002 is "Why the sticker on the back of the windshield?" With everyone pulling into their parking space, we will be able to do away with the sticker within 9 months to a year. I look forward to returning back to Staff Senate and discussing our new system further.
